ITINERARY

Day 1: AUGUST 4th (Wednesday), 2027

Departure from our countries of origin on an intercontinental flight. Meals will be served onboard. Overnight flight.

Day 2: AUGUST 5th (Thursday), 2027 – SEOUL

Welcome to a new continent: WELCOME TO ASIA. Welcome to a new country: WELCOME TO SOUTH KOREA.

After arriving at Incheon International Airport in Seoul, we will proceed through immigration and baggage claim. Meet our representative, who will be waiting with a sign displaying our group name. We will then board our private transfer to the hotel in Seoul for check-in (check-in begins at 3:00 PM). Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 3: AUGUST 6th (Friday), 2027 - SEOUL: WORLD YOUTH DAY

Breakfast included. After breakfast, we will board our bus and transfer to the World Youth Day venue (includes morning transfer and afternoon return to the hotel). Day dedicated to World Youth Day events, which often include activities such as the Stations of the Cross or a procession before the vigil.

If the event ends early, there will be an opportunity to explore central Seoul during the rest of the afternoon and evening using public transportation. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 4: AUGUST 7th (Saturday), 2027 - SEOUL: WORLD YOUTH DAY

Breakfast included. Morning transfer to the World Youth Day venue. Full day dedicated to all World Youth Day activities. Overnight vigil at the WYD event.

Day 5: AUGUST 8th (Sunday), 2027 - SEOUL: WORLD YOUTH DAY

Day dedicated to all World Youth Day activities. After the events conclude, we will board our bus and return to the hotel. Free afternoon and evening to explore Seoul at your own pace. Opportunity to visit central city areas using public transportation. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 6: AUGUST 9th (Monday), 2027 - SEOUL CITY TOUR “THE HEART OF SOUTH KOREA”

Breakfast included. Guided city tour featuring Gyeongbokgung Royal Palace, the National Museum, and the famous Changing of the Guard ceremony.





We continue to Bukchon Hanok Village, with its traditional Korean homes and scenic alleyways. Visit the Church of the Holy Name of Jesus, considered the birthplace of the Catholic Church in Korea, where the first Catholic Mass in the country was celebrated in 1795. Celebration of Holy Mass.

Walk through Insadong for artisan shops, galleries, and tea houses. Free time for lunch at a traditional Korean restaurant. Visit Jogyesa Temple, City Hall Plaza, and Myeongdong Cathedral, seat of the Archdiocese of Seoul, where relics of Saint Andrew Kim Taegon may be venerated.

Free time in Myeongdong for shopping and cafés. Later, visit Seosomun Shrine and History Museum, one of the most significant Catholic sites in Korea, honoring 19th-century martyrs. Return to hotel. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 7: AUGUST 10th (Tuesday), 2027 – SEOUL (JEOLDUSAN MARTYRS SHRINE AND GANGNAM DISTRICT)

Breakfast included. Visit Jeoldusan, a major martyrdom site for Korean Catholics, built to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the Byeonin Persecution. Saint John Paul II and Mother Teresa visited this site in 1984 and 1985. Celebration of Holy Mass.

Continue to Gangnam, Seoul’s most modern and iconic district. Free time for lunch and exploration. Visit Gangnam Station shopping area, COEX Mall, the world-famous Starfield Library, the Gangnam Style monument, and Bongeunsa Buddhist Temple. Return to hotel. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 8: AUGUST 11th (Wednesday), 2027 – SEOUL (DMZ DEMILITARIZED ZONE)

Breakfast included. Morning excursion to the world-famous Demilitarized Zone (DMZ). Visit Imjingak, Dorasan Station, the Third Infiltration Tunnel, and Dora Observatory, where you can view North Korea. Time for photos and commentary from the guide about the Korean War and peace efforts.

Free time for lunch. Return to Seoul in the afternoon with free time to continue exploring. Optional excursions include the Hangang River Cruise and N Seoul Tower for panoramic city views. You may also visit Hongdae Walking Street or Itaewon. Return to hotel. Overnight stay in Seoul.

Day 9: AUGUST 12th (Thursday), 2027 – SEOUL

Breakfast included. If flight schedules allow, free time to explore Seoul. Optional self-guided train trip to Mirinae Shrine, burial place of Saint Andrew Kim Taegon, the first Korean Catholic priest and martyr. Opportunity for Holy Mass.

At the scheduled time, transfer to Incheon International Airport for your return flight to your home country. Meals served onboard. Overnight flight. Have a blessed journey. God bless you all.
