ITINERARY

DAY 1. AUGUST 12th, 2027 – TOKYO

Arrival at Tokyo International Airport (Narita or Haneda). Immigration process and baggage claim. Welcome to a new country: WELCOME TO JAPAN. Reception by our representative, who will guide you to board the bus that will take you to the hotel. Check-in at the hotel. We prepare to begin our adventure in Japan. Overnight stay in Tokyo.

DAY 2. AUGUST 13th, 2027 – TOKYO

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will board our bus to begin our visit through Tokyo, a city where imperial history and futuristic innovation coexist in an extraordinary way.

Our first stop will be the IMPERIAL PALACE PLAZA, the official residence of the Japanese Imperial Family. This site symbolizes Japan's historical continuity from the era of the emperors to the present day, and stands on the former grounds of Edo Castle, the center of samurai power for centuries. We will continue to ASAKUSA KANNON TEMPLE (Senso-ji), the oldest and most revered Buddhist temple in Tokyo. Founded in the 7th century, it remains an important spiritual center for the Japanese people. Here we will experience local devotion, incense, and the sacred atmosphere that has attracted pilgrims for generations. Free time for lunch at one of the traditional Japanese restaurants.

Next, we will walk through the famous NAKAMISE STREET, a vibrant traditional corridor filled with century-old shops. This location allows us to connect with Japanese culture through handcrafted goods, traditional sweets, and unique souvenirs. Afterward, we will enjoy a completely different experience at TEAMLAB, an immersive digital museum that redefines contemporary art. Here, technology and creativity come together to create interactive spaces where the visitor becomes part of the artwork itself.

We will end the day at the iconic SHIBUYA CROSSING. Get your phone cameras ready. You are about to walk across “the busiest pedestrian crossing in the world.” This place represents the energy, dynamism, and fast pace of modern life in Tokyo. At the end of the day, we will return to the hotel.

Overnight stay in Tokyo.

DAY 3. AUGUST 14th, 2027 – TOKYO – MOUNT FUJI – TOKYO

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for one of Japan’s most iconic experiences: the MOUNT FUJI AND HAKONE region. Our first stop will be the picturesque village of OSHINO HAKKAI, known for its eight crystal-clear ponds formed by the melting snow of Mount Fuji. This site is considered a cultural heritage location, as it preserves the essence of traditional rural Japan and offers privileged views of the country’s most sacred mountain. We will continue to LAKE ASHI, where we will enjoy a scenic cruise. This lake, formed inside the crater of an ancient volcano, offers breathtaking views of Mount Fuji on clear days. From here, it is also possible to see the famous floating torii gate of Hakone Shrine, a spiritual symbol representing the connection between humanity and the divine.

Free time for lunch. Afterward, we will board the HAKONE ROPEWAY, a cable car that takes us above active volcanic landscapes while offering spectacular panoramic views of the region. Our final stop will be OWAKUDANI VALLEY, an active volcanic area famous for its steam vents, sulfuric waters, and almost mystical landscape. This site is a reminder of the living force of nature and one of the most impressive points in the region. At the end of the visit, we will board our bus once again to return to Tokyo.

Overnight stay in Tokyo.

DAY 4. AUGUST 15th, 2027 – TOKYO – (BULLET TRAIN) – KYOTO

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will board our bus and head to TOKYO CATHEDRAL, seat of the Archdiocese and the Catholic Church in Japan, to attend Sunday Mass.

After Mass, get ready, because we are about to board the BULLET TRAIN that will take us to the world-famous city of KYOTO. Free time for lunch. Upon arrival, we will board our bus, which will take us to the hotel for check-in.

Overnight stay in Kyoto.

DAY 5. AUGUST 16th, 2027 – KYOTO

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will board our bus to discover Kyoto, the ancient imperial capital of Japan and one of the country’s most iconic destinations, where tradition remains alive in every corner.

We will begin with a visit to the GOLDEN PAVILION (Kinkaku-ji), a Zen temple covered in gold leaf that reflects its splendor over a peaceful pond. This site is not only an architectural masterpiece, but also a symbol of harmony between humanity and nature, representing the refined aesthetics of classical Japan.

We will continue to KIYOMIZU-DERA TEMPLE, one of the most important temples in the country, founded in the 8th century. Its famous wooden terrace, built without nails, offers spectacular views of the city and has served for centuries as a place of pilgrimage and prayer. Free time for lunch.





Afterward, we will walk through SANNENZAKA, a charming traditional slope lined with wooden houses, shops, and cafés. This location transports us to ancient Japan, allowing us to experience the authentic atmosphere of the samurai era. And now, get your phone cameras ready. You are about to arrive at one of the most famous places in all of Japan. Millions of people from around the world travel here to take photos at the breathtaking FUSHIMI INARI TAISHA SHRINE, famous for its thousands of red torii gates that create pathways through the mountain. Dedicated to the god of rice and prosperity, this shrine is one of the most sacred and visited places in Japan, offering a truly unique spiritual experience. Return to the hotel. Overnight stay in Kyoto.

DAY 6. AUGUST 17th, 2027 – KYOTO – NARA – OSAKA

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will check out and depart for the city of NARA, the first permanent capital of Japan and the birthplace of its cultural and religious heritage. Our visit will begin at the famous NARA PARK, also known as the park of the sacred deer. These animals have been considered divine messengers in the Shinto tradition for centuries, and their free presence creates a unique and deeply symbolic experience. We will continue to the majestic TODAI-JI TEMPLE, one of the most important Buddhist complexes in the world. Inside, it houses the impressive GREAT BRONZE BUDDHA (Daibutsu), one of the largest statues of its kind in the world. This temple represents the spiritual and political power of ancient Japan. Free time for lunch. Afterward, we will stroll through the old town of Nara, where the traditional streets, shops, and temples reflect the historical essence of the country. This setting allows us to better understand the origins of Japanese identity. At the end of the visit, we will board our bus once again and continue toward Osaka, a vibrant and modern city, where we will check in at the hotel.



Overnight stay in Osaka.

DAY 7. AUGUST 18th, 2027 – OSAKA

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will begin our visit through OSAKA, one of Japan's most dynamic cities, known for its energy, cuisine, and urban lifestyle. Our first stop will be the impressive OSAKA CASTLE, one of the most famous and spectacular fortresses in the country. Built in the 16th century by Toyotomi Hideyoshi, it played a key role in the unification of Japan. Today, it stands as a historical symbol that allows us to better understand the samurai era and the struggles for power. Free time for lunch. We will continue to the lively district of DOTONBORI, famous for its neon lights, canal, and vibrant atmosphere. This location represents the most modern and entertaining side of Osaka and is also a key place to enjoy the city's local food culture. Finally, we will visit SHINSAIBASHI, one of the city's most important shopping districts. Its covered shopping arcade combines traditional and modern stores, offering a complete shopping experience in the heart of Osaka. Afterward, we will board our bus once again and return to the hotel.

Overnight stay in Osaka.





DAY 8. AUGUST 19th, 2027 – OSAKA

Breakfast included. After enjoying breakfast at the hotel, we will have a completely free day to continue exploring Osaka on our own and at our own pace. Personalized recommendations for activities available during the day will be provided, along with opportunities to once again enjoy traditional Japanese cuisine at some of the city's famous restaurants. At the designated time, we will board our bus and head to Osaka International Airport to board our return flights to our countries of origin. Transcontinental flight. Meals will be served onboard. Overnight flight.
